- 3:00 Each rider may work a cow in a "class" for 5 minutes

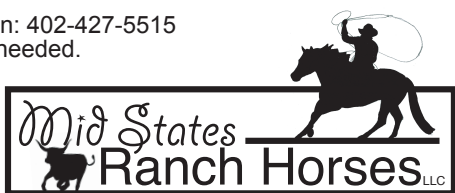
